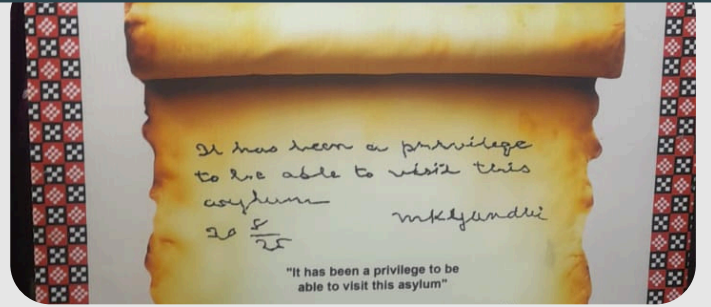

# The Centenary Celebration of M. K. Gandhi's arrival in Cuttack



To commemorate 100 years of this transformative visit, the city of Cuttack and especially the Leprosy Home and Hospital, Nayabazar, Cuttack, organised an array of events and cultural programs. The celebrations were designed not only to honour Gandhi's memory but also to rekindle the spirit of his teachings. The centenary celebration of the arrival of Mohandas Karamchan Gandhi, the father of the nation, in Nehrupalli, Cuttack, was solemnised on 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2025, by the Government offices, school staff, people from



Nehrupalli and Gandhipalli colonies. This celebration was to mark the memories of Mahatma Gandhi's arrival in Cuttack on 20<sup>th</sup> August 1925, and especially, he visited the Leprosy Ashram, where the patients of leprosy are treated. In the Ashram, Mahatma Gandhi served the people. In remembrance of his service and visitation, a statue of Mahatma Gandhi is installed. The program began with the inauguration of the statue of Gandhi. Thousands of people from colonies, cities and high dignified government officers, political leaders and media were present in the celebration. The occasion of the 100<sup>th</sup> year of the Padayatra of Mahatma Gandhi

was graced by Dr Hari Babu Kambhampati, the Honourable Governor of Odisha, as the Chief Guest. It was a joyful moment to be a part of the celebration. It is a more joyful and memorable event for us as we were invited as special guests for the program. Our Congregation and, especially, the Damien Social Development Institute were honored with the certificate in recognition of our dedicated service to the leprosy people. ## Opening of New Non-Formal Tuition Centers



In its continued commitment to the education and holistic development of underprivileged children, Damien Social Development Institute (DSDI) opened four new Non-Formal Tuition Centers during this year. Of these, three centers were established in Odisha and one center in Kunjaban, West Bengal, all within DSDI's pastoral areas. This initiative marks another significant step in reaching out to marginalized communities and responding to the educational needs of children.

DSDI carefully assessed the needs and challenges faced by children and families in these regions, especially in the area of education. 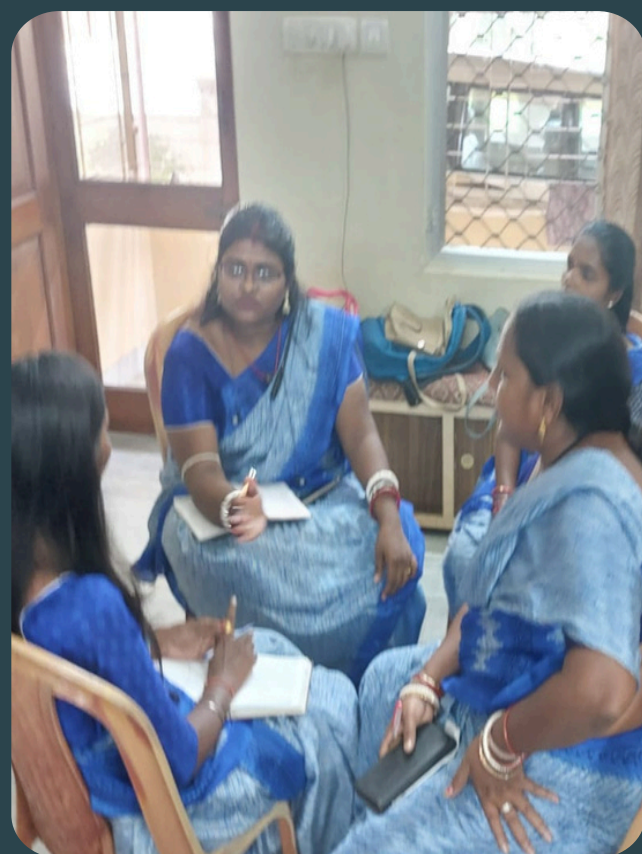
